An easy to use and install booking program for up to 30 resources. The program does not use the registry so can be installed and tested off the system and transferred to the system area by copying and pasting the directory. Resources can be organized into groups, each group can have different booking schedules. When setting up the term dates it is easy to nominate public holidays and other school events such as swimming carnivals. After talking to staff who are using the program they felt that it was easy to use; with a logical screen presentation, colour coding and a simple booking process. The booking process requires 4 pieces of data: teacher, subject, class and purpose. Teachers were particularly pleased that records were kept of non-permanent bookings that were deleted.

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
